

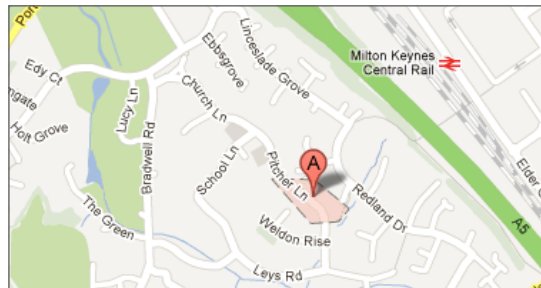

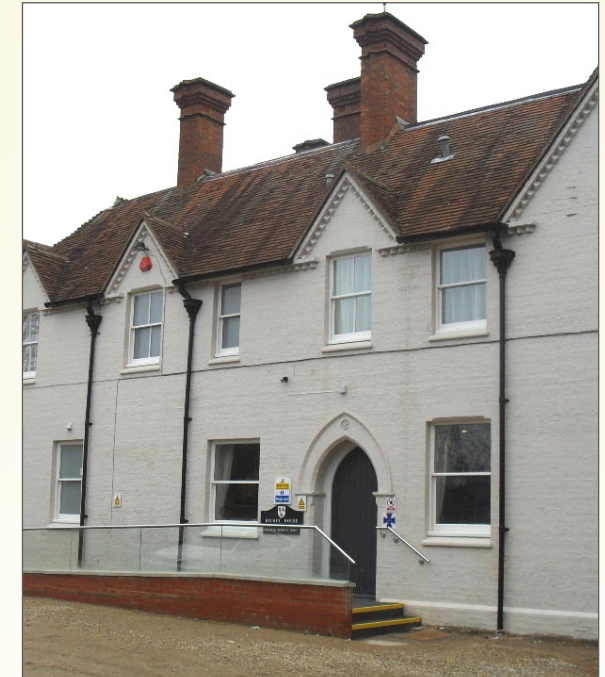

CARE PHILOSOPHY

Becket House provides Nursing Care for elderly and residents with a Dementia.

We aim to provide a satisfying life for all our residents, with our philosophy centred on the individuals' right to achieve and maintain, **PRIVACY, DIGNITY, INDEPENDENCE, CHOICE** and **FULFILMENT** regardless of their physical or mental capabilities. The basis of our approach is laid out in the service users guide displayed in each room.

Having undertaken a major refurbishment programme, we offer quality bedrooms, mainly en-suite, supplemented by pleasant spacious lounges and dining room.

CARE FACILITIES

There are television and telephone points in all rooms, nurse call points and fully furnished. On agreement with the manager, personal furniture can be put into the rooms, and we encourage personalisation. All bedding and towels are supplied and our in house laundry is included in the fees. Visitors are encouraged at all times of the day and can choose where they meet, either in 1 of the lounges, dining room or bedroom. We aim to create a homely atmosphere and foster relations with the local community. We have an activities co-ordinator, who inspires our residents to participate in both mental and physical stimulation.

STAFFING

Much depends on our staff, who are chosen for their professionalism friendliness and commitment to providing high standards of care for our residents. We have a commitment to continually train our staff and assist with obtaining recognised qualifications. A qualified manager and trained nurses, oversee the smooth day to day running of the home.



FINANCE

Fees payable for long term care by service user will be linked to individual needs as defined through the assessment and re-assessment process. Other services such as hairdressing, chiropody, dry cleaning and newspaper are provided at an additional cost.

Individual finance package for the provision of care can be confidentially discussed with the manager who can advise on eligibility and access to other sources of funding.
